The Nurse Aide has direct contact with facility residents on a continual basis, and is generally responsible for providing continuity of care for each resident he or she is responsible for. The Nurse Aide reports to nursing supervisors and the Director of Nursing.

In order to become a State Tested Nursing Assistant, a nurse aide training course must be successfully completed, as well as a passing score on the state-mandated test on the knowledge and skills learned from the course. Enrolling in our program is your first step towards a wonderful and rewarding career in the long-term healthcare industry.
